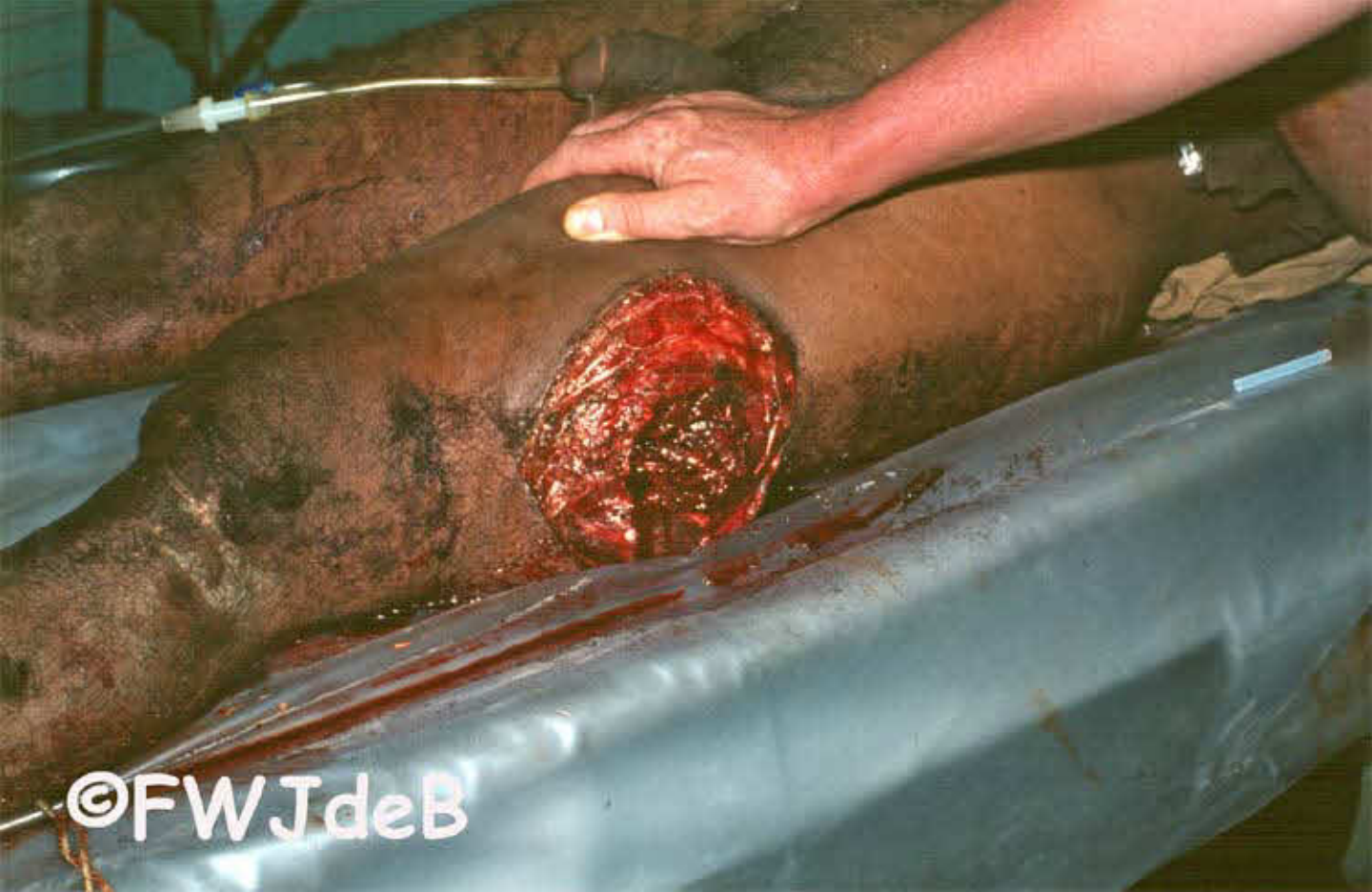

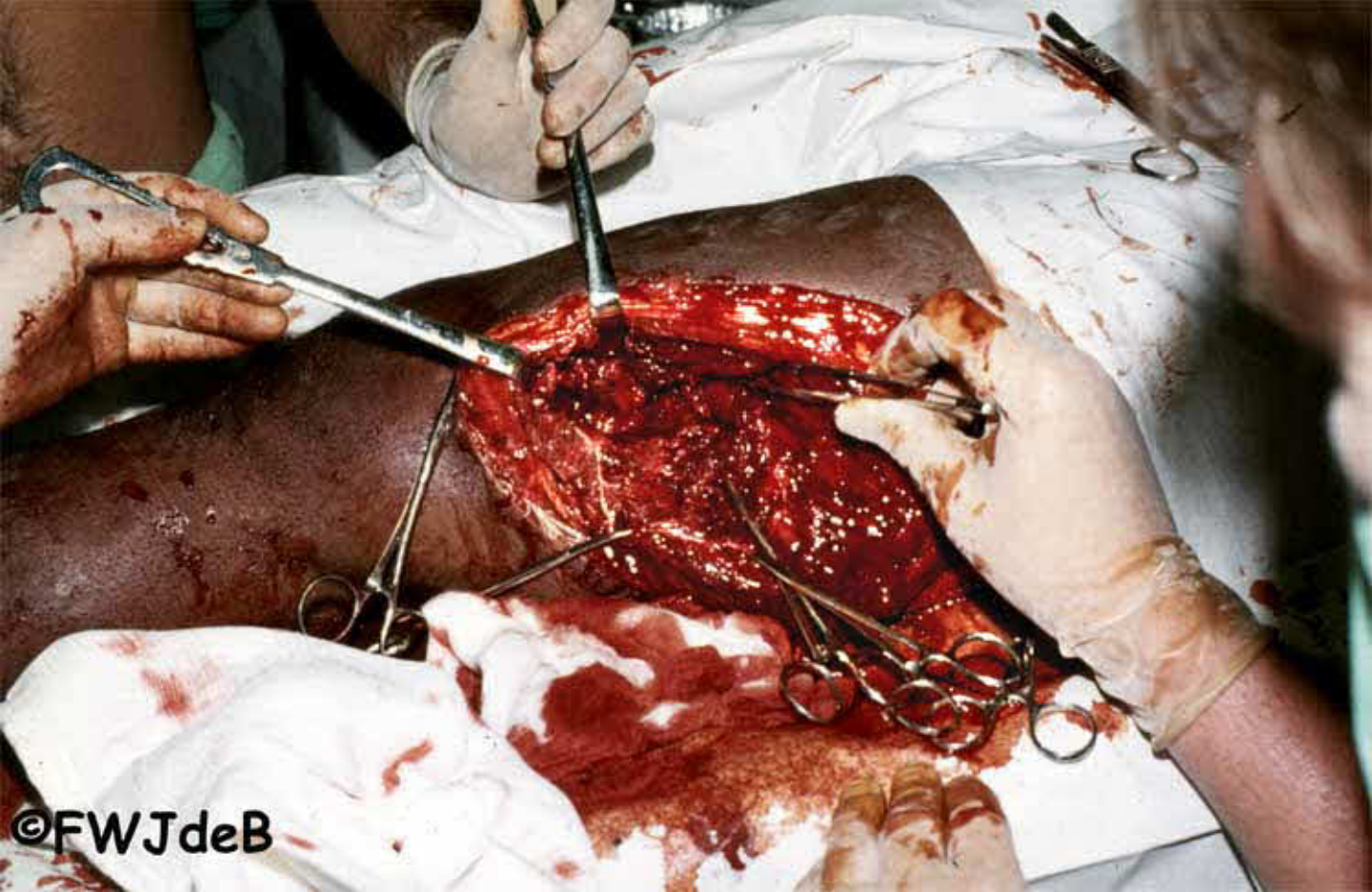

The characteristics of the discharge that injured him would have been as follows presumably from close range...

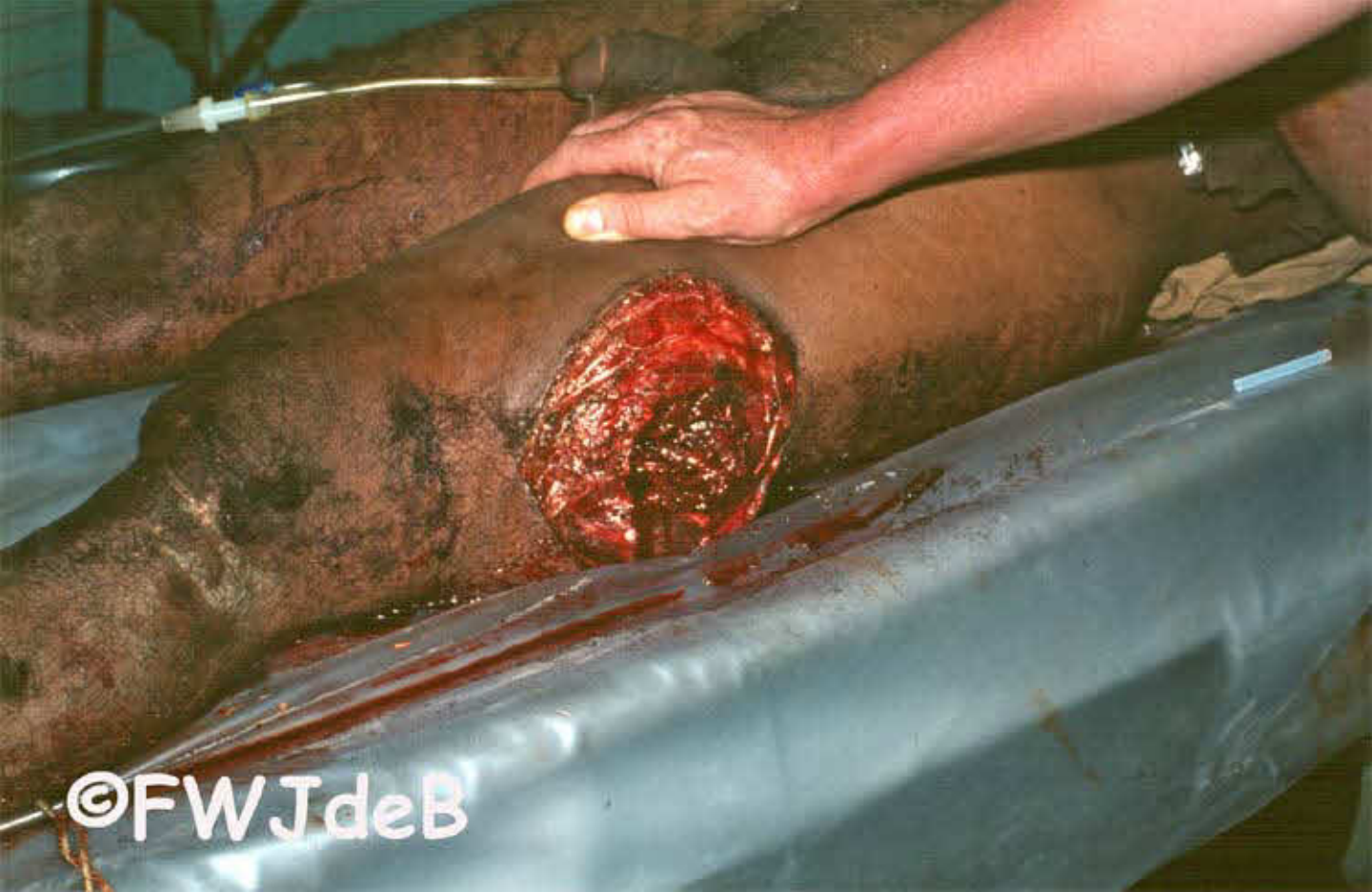

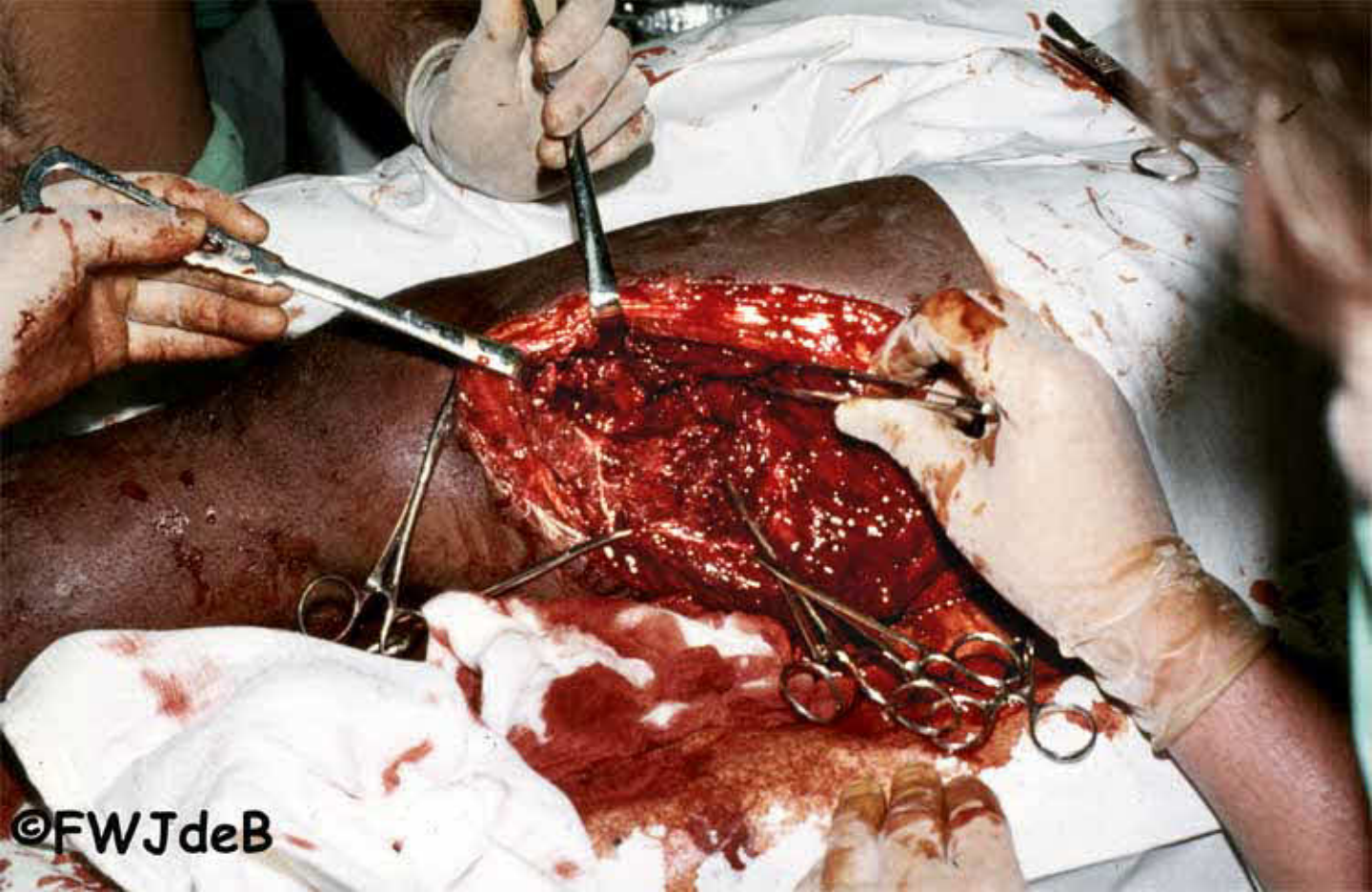
